Gave the group handouts – sample from Tustin USD and a calendar. Explained that Illuminate has a grade book option available. Calendar shows a lot of back end work in the set up which Rachel would be doing. Illuminate is offering workshops in which she will be attending. Ask the group to create what they would like to see on the report card. If we go this way, the only items that would need to be manually populated in the report card is comments and attendance (attendance not avail in Illuminate at this time). In the beginning it is very tedious, but once the hard work and building is out of the way it will operate very smoothly. Easier to “tweak it” after it’s been created. <b>Common Assessments</b>	<p><u>SBAC (Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• California has paid for the Interim Assessments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 2 Types</li> <li>○ Interim Comprehensive Assessment (ICA) – <i>what we just did</i></li> <li>○ Interim Assessment Blocks (IAB) – focus on smaller sets of related concepts and provide more detailed information for instructional purposes. There are between five and seventeen blocks per subject per grade.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Possible Scenarios for next year</li> <li>• Ren Place – Star Enterprise (Math and ELA) can be used as a Common Assessment</li> </ul> <p>→ HC advised group that we can do again what we just did with the Interims by giving the ICAs or we could give the Blocks or a mixture of both. Asked if we need to create our own assessments, but with the blocks we already have them built for us which would mean that we would not have to build our own. Not completely sure, but believes that CAASPP is building a gr 2 interim assessment. We don't want to over test our students because it brings more pressure to the students and teachers. Mr. Y informed that the blocks do not have hand-scoring with it, however the students will not get the exposure to the open-end constructive type questions. We can build our own performance task to give them that experience and over time build better and better assessments. HC stated we can decide what is best for our district. We can do just math, or just ELA, or both but what would be best for our students. Asked the group to return to their sites to ask questions and gather up staff opinions regarding this. HC stated we could do 1/2 one time and the second 1/2 another time. There are many different options as to how we are going to do this, but needs feedback from the sites.</p>	<p>Heidi D. Explained that in the middle of SBAC window is the CST Science window to be aware of this. Need to be creative with how to test our students. For the HS, the EAP is embedded in with the SBAC. This is a positive. Mr. Y informed group of the new CAPA assessment CAA (Ca Alternate Assessment) field test where all eligible students will need to test. HC also informed that our scores may not “count” this year depending on how this looks. The state to make decision soon on whether this year or next year’s scores will be our baseline. Currently there are teachers who are piloting the HM and Pearson programs and we need feedback on this soon. Hope to have a decision soon and hopefully have TE's in the teachers' hands in May. If no good feedback then we will go back and restart the process. HC they review the materials either at their sites (see their principals) or when the materials return back to the ESC on March 9. This is only going to be for gr K-5 for now. Kilty P mentioned that we need to have a positive attitude and for teachers to review the materials because it is no fun to be stuck with something they don't like. HC not going by what other school districts has selected. (i.e.: Barstow USD went with Go Math. Whatever we choose needs to be CCSS aligned, Go Math does not follow this.) Cathy feels that curriculum has been 'thrown' together quickly to meet CCSS and wondered if other better material may be available if we wait one more year? Mr. Y stated based on what we've seen for us, this seems to work for us. Cathy felt product is not user friendly. Mr. Y states that this is the type of feedback that the district needs back and recommends they put this in the boxes at the sites that were set up for feedback.</p>
