This is an opportunity for parents to enroll their student(s) at a centralized location in our district. Please bring the following documentation to complete enrollment:

- *Birth Certificate/Passport/Baptismal Certificate (original)*
- *Proof of Residency (i.e. driver's license, utility bill, rental agreement)*
- *Custody Orders (if applicable)*
- *Legal Guardian Documentation (if applicable)*
- *Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan (if applicable) NOTE: Psychologists will be available for evaluations. If your child has an IEP or a 504 Plan, please bring current information with you on those days*
- *Most recent report card or transcript*
- *Most recent state testing results*
- *Inter-district Transfer paperwork if you reside outside of the district boundaries*
- *Up-to-Date Immunization Record (see chart on back)*
- *Completed Physical Form – For Kinder & 1st grade only (not required for Transitional Kindergarten, but please provide if available)*
 - Kindergarten: dated within 6 months prior of the first day of school or 1st grade within 18 months prior to first day of school
 - Sports Physicals: Middle and High School Only
- *Completed Oral Health Screening – For Kinder & 1st grade only (not required for Transitional Kindergarten, but please provide if available)*
 - Kindergarten: Date will be accepted up to 12 months prior to first day of school
- *Three local emergency contact names and numbers*

In addition to enrolling all your children in one location, you will be able to arrange:

- *Ft. Irwin M.S. students will be assessed for grade level readiness in both English language Arts and Mathematics between 8-10 am each day or to set an appointment between 7/28-8/1 call [760-386-1133](tel:760-386-1133)*
- *Transportation for your children*
- *Forms to administer medication needed at school*
- *Meet with School Psychologist if your student is in Special Education*
- *Pick up paperwork to volunteer at your child's school*
- *Pick up applications for any vacant classified positions, i.e., Noon Duty Aide, Cafeteria Help, substitute jobs such as Clerical, Cafeteria and Custodial*
- *Receive information on parent organizations for your child's school*
- *Receive information on orientation and tour of your child's school*
- *Schedule appointments with the principal at the time of enrollment for Inter-District Transfers*
- *Meet with the District Nurse if your student has any health concerns or specialized procedures i.e.; EPI Pen, seizures, diabetes, etc.*
- *Obtain physical forms for sports programs (Middle/High School)*



IMMUNIZATIONS/California Requirements
 Parents: Children need to have these immunizations
BEFORE they can begin school

VACCINE	REQUIRED DOSES
Polio	4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement for ages 4-6 years if at least one was given on or after the 4 th birthday ¹ ; 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7-17 years if at least one was given on or after the 2 nd birthday. ¹
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis	Age 6 years and under: DPT, DTaP or any combination of DTP or DTaP with DT (diphtheria and tetanus) 5 doses at any age, but... 4 doses meet requirements for ages 4-6 years if at least one was on or after the 4 th birthday. ¹
	Age 7 years and older: Tdap, TD, Td, or DTP, DTaP or any combination of these 4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement for ages 7-17 years if at least one was on or after the 2 nd birthday. ¹
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	Kindergarten: 2 doses ² both on or after 1 st birthday. ¹
	7 th grade: 2 doses ² both on or after 1 st birthday. ¹
	Grades 1-6 and 8-12: 1 dose on or after 1 st birthday. ¹
Hepatitis B ³	Kindergarten: 3 doses at any age
Varicella	1 dose ^{4,6}
Tdap Booster (Tetanus, reduced diphtheria, and pertussis)	7 th grade: 1 dose on or after 7 th birthday. ^{5,7}

Physicals

- i Kindergarten physicals must be dated within 6 months of 1st day of school
- i First grade physicals must be dated within 18 months of 1st day of school
- i Sports physicals must be dated within 1 year prior to participating in practices or games

Oral Health Screenings

- i Kindergarten: Date will be accepted up to 12 months prior of 1st day of school year
- i First grade: If child did not attend kindergarten, they must have screening. Date will be accepted 12 months prior of school year or first time enrolled in school

**YOU WILL NEED TO SHOW YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORD
 TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR SCHOOL**

¹ Receipt of a dose up to (and including) 4 days before the birthday will satisfy the school entry immunization requirement.

² Two doses of measles-containing vaccine required. One dose of mumps and rubella-containing vaccine required; mumps vaccine is not required for children 7 years of age and older.

³ Not required for 7th grade.

⁴ Physician-documented varicella (chickenpox) disease history or immunity meets the varicella requirement.

⁵ Tdap, DTaP, or DTP given on or after 7th birthday will meet the requirement. TD does not meet the requirement

⁶ 2 dose varicella requirement for ages 13-17 years applies to transfer students who were not admitted to a California school before July 1, 2001.

⁷ Grade 8-12 students transferring from outside of California must meet the requirement.
