

### SHORT LIST OF PARENT RIGHTS

1. The right to a free, appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment at no cost to parents.
2. The right to an unbiased assessment by qualified persons; and a written copy of assessment reports.
3. The right to meet at least one time per year for the Individual Education Plan to discuss the student's progress.
4. The right to examine all your child's school records.
5. If a parent has a disagreement with the district, the parent has both local and state due process hearing rights and complaint procedures.
