SHORT LIST OF PARENT RIGHTS

- 1. The right to a free, appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment at no cost to parents.
- 2. The right to an unbiased assessment by qualified persons; and a written copy of assessment reports.
- 3. The right to meet at least one time per year for the Individual Education Plan to discuss the student's progress.
- The right to examine all your child's school records.
- 5. If a parent has a disagreement with the district, the parent has both local and state due process hearing rights and complaint procedures.
