This is an opportunity for parents to enroll their student(s) at a centralized location in our district. The counselor and staff from Silver Valley High School will be available on all three days to ensure students are scheduled into their appropriate classes.

Please bring the following documentation to complete enrollment:

- *Birth Certificate/Passport/Baptismal Certificate (Original)*
- *Proof of Residency (i.e. Driver's License, utility bill, rental agreement)*
- *Custody Orders (if applicable)*
- *Legal Guardian Documentation (If applicable)*
- *Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan (If applicable)*
- *Most Recent Report Card or Transcript*
- *Most Recent State Testing Results*
- *Inter-district Transfer paperwork if you reside outside of the district boundaries*
- *Up-to-Date Immunization Record (see chart on back)*
- *Completed Physical Form – For Kinder & 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Only (Not required for Transitional Kindergarten, but please provide if available)*
  - Kindergarten: Within 6 months of the first day of school year or 1<sup>st</sup> Grade within 18 months of first day of school year
  - Sports Physicals: Middle and High School Only
- *Completed Oral Health Screening – For Kinder & 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Only (Not required for Transitional Kindergarten, but please provide if available)*
  - Kindergarten: Within 6 months of the first day of school year or 1<sup>st</sup> Grade within 18 months of first day of school year
- *Three Local Emergency Contact Names and Numbers*

In addition to enrolling all your children in one location, you will be able to arrange:

- *Transportation for your children*
- *Forms to Administer Medication needed at school*
- *Meet with School Psychologist if your student is in Special Education*
- *Pick up paperwork to volunteer at your child's school*
- *Pick up applications for any vacant classified positions, i.e. Noon Duty Aide, Cafeteria Help, Substitute jobs such as Clerical, Cafeteria and Custodial*
- *Receive information on parent organizations for your child's school*
- *Receive information on orientation and tour of your child's school*
- *Schedule appointments with the Principal at the time of enrollment for inter-district transfers*
- *Meet with District Nurse if your student has any health concerns or specialized procedures i.e.: EPI Pen, seizures, diabetes, etc.*
- *Obtain physical forms for sports programs (Middle/High School)*

## IMMUNIZATIONS/California Requirements



**Parents: Children need to have these shots before they can begin school**

**VACCINE**

**Polio**

**Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis**

Age 6 years and under (Pertussis is required)

DTP, Dtap or any combination of DTP

Or DtaP with DT (tetanus and diphtheria)

Age 7 years and older (Pertussis not required) Td,

DT or DTP, DtaP or any combination of these

7<sup>th</sup> grade

TB booster

Tdap (Whooping Cough) Grades 7-12

**Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)**

Kindergarten

7<sup>th</sup> grade

Grades 1-6 and 8-12

**Hepatitis B**

Kindergarten

7<sup>th</sup> grade

**Varicella**

Kindergarten

Out-of-State entrants (grades 1-12)

**REQUIRED DOES**

**4 doses at any age, but...**3 doses meet requirement of ages 4-6 years if at least one was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday (1); 3 doses meet requirement for after 7-17 years if at least one was given on or after the 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday (1).

**5 doses at any age, but...** 4 doses meet requirement for ages 4-6 years if at least one was on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday (1).

**4 doses at any age, but...**3 doses meet Requirement for ages 7-17 years if at least one was on or after the 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday (1). If last dose was given before the 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday, one more (Td) Dose is required. **1 dose** not required but recommended if more than 5 years have passes since last DTP, DtaP, DT or Td dose.

**2 doses** (2) both on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (1)

**2 doses** (2) both on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (1)

**1 dose** must be on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (1)

**3 doses**

**3 doses**

**1 dose** (4)

**1 dose** for children under 13 years; 2 doses are Needed if immunized on or after 13 birthday (4)

**Physicals**

- Kindergarten physicals must be dated within 6 months of 1<sup>st</sup> day of school
- First Grade physicals must be dated within 18 months of 1<sup>st</sup> day of school
- Sports physicals must be dated within 1 year prior to participating in practices or games

**Oral Health Screenings**

- Kindergarten: Date will be accepted up to 12 months within 1 year of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school year
- First Grade: If child did not attend kindergarten, they must have screening. Date will be accepted 12 months within 1 year of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school year or first time enrolled in school

**You will need to show your child's immunization record to register your child for school**
